Thank you for your November 15, 2021, memorandum providing additional information about the Grayson E. Annas Commercial Building and House (CW0431) concurring that the resource is eligible under:

- Criterion A as an intact example of a rural house and store complex from the mid-20th century that well represents a significant trend in commercial and residential complexes that became common throughout the state. And
- Criterion C as representative of a distinctive resource type (rural house and store complex) that retains a high degree of integrity. It is also locally significant as the resource type is rare in Caldwell County, with other notable examples only found in surrounding counties and parts of the state.

The proposed boundary outlined in red in the report appears appropriate for the property.

Thank you for your response to our Historic Structures Survey Report for the abovereferenced project. We have reviewed the comments provided regarding the overall report structure, the Grayson E. Annas Commercial Building and House (CW0431) and the Lawrence C. Hartley House (CW043).

After reviewing the comments provided on the Grayson E. Annas Commercial Building and House (CW0431) and conducting additional research, we concur that the resource is eligible under Criterion A as an intact example of a rural house and store complex from the mid-20<sup>th</sup> century that well represents a significant trend in commercial and residential complexes that became common throughout the state. We also concur that the Grayson E. Annas Commercial Building and House is eligible under Criterion C as representative of a distinctive resource type (rural house and store complex) that retains a high degree of integrity. It is also locally significant as the resource type is rare in Caldwell County, with other notable examples only found in surrounding counties and parts of the state. We propose a National Register boundary that follows the parcel boundary (PIN 2766165481) to the north and east, a modified boundary that follows the majority of the parcel boundary to the west but excludes a small bump out that partially encroaches on the adjoining property's driveway, and the edge of pavement along Cajah Mountain Road to the south.
